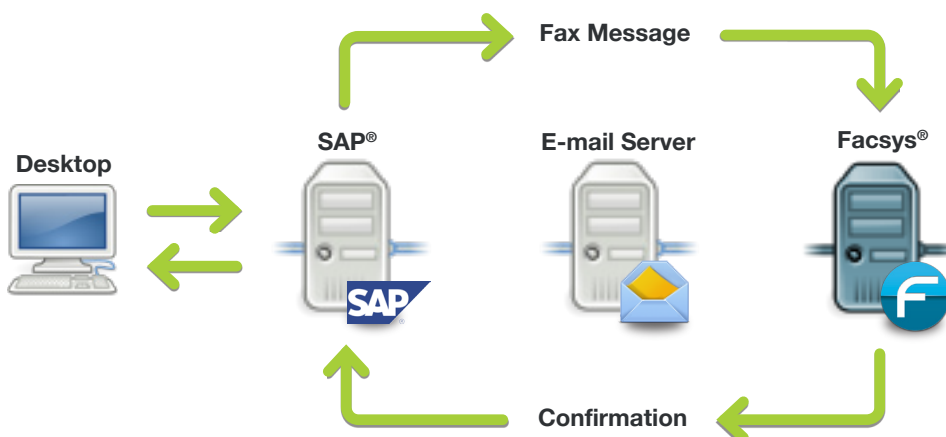

The SMTP Connector seamlessly integrates Facsys into SAP applications - enabling automated document delivery to shorten transaction times and streamline business processes. Whether it's automated production faxing or individual user tasks such as faxing orders, receipt of delivery confirmations, invoices, contracts, and other critical documents - it can all be done with ease directly from an SAP application or SAPconnect.

Any SAP system can output fax messages as SMTP messages to the Connector for processing by the Facsys server. Once the fax has been sent, a delivery status notification (DSN) is returned through the Connector and the fax status is entered into the logs of the sending module. The Connector is an add-on module available to be installed on the Facsys server.

Send fax messages and receive confirmations within your SAP applications using **Solgenia® Facsys® SMTP Connector for SAP®**.

### Typical Scenario



As of SAP Release 6.20, users can send and receive fax messages using SMTP. These are packed in e-mails for the purpose of routing messages to a fax server.


When sending, the mail server refers to the domain of the recipients' addresses, and directs the e-mails to an internal company fax server (eg. "FAX=+491759628717@fax.company.com").

When receiving, the fax server sends e-mails to addresses with the domain of the SAP system (eg. "FAX=+496227751624@SAP.company.com").

## Easy Set Up

Configuring SAP to send fax messages using Facsys is as simple as using the SAPConnect: Administration (system status) screen to configure the SMTP node found beneath the FAX Telefax node.

Click on the "Set" button on the screen beside "Fax" and in the "Conversion into Internet Address" section, set the "Domain" field to "your\_domain.COM" to correspond with your Facsys server.



Once you have opened up the SMTP node enter the Facsys server hostname under "Mail Host" in the properties of the "SMTP" node.

Make sure that the "Node in use" checkbox is ticked to ensure that it is active.
